- Give it away!
 - \$500,000 to community grants and partnerships
 - \$50,000 in sponsoring events
 - \$160,000 for this year's NetHui
 - \$900,000 on Internet Issues

COMMUNITY GRANTS AND PARTNERSHIPS

- \$100,000 p/a to 2020 Communications Trust
- \$100,000 p/a to NetSafe
- \$5,000 for supporting a copyright, privacy and surveillance conference
- \$3,500 for research on Maori language usage online
- Heaps of other grants for research, projects and conference attendance – feel free to apply!
